Summary (as of Jan 19, 2022)

This resolution expresses the policy of the United States for addressing and mitigating national security challenges, including the spread of infectious diseases and pandemics, the climate crisis, the proliferation and threat of the use of nuclear weapons, human rights violations, corruption, conflict, and violence, authoritarianism, gender, economic, and social inequality, and transnational White supremacist violence and racist nationalism.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 20, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **Jan 19, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 19, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services, Ways and Means, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jan 19, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
