Small and Homestead Independent Producers Act of 2022

This bill provides authority for small cultivators of marijuana and small manufacturers of marijuana products to ship and sell the marijuana or marijuana products using the U.S. Postal Service or a private or commercial interstate carrier.

Specifically, marijuana or a marijuana product may be shipped or sold to individuals within a state or another state in which the possession of it is lawful by such individuals.

The bill takes effect on the date on which marijuana is removed from the list of scheduled substances under the Controlled Substances Act and federal criminal penalties for an individual who manufactures, distributes, or possesses marijuana, are eliminated.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Biotechnology, Horticulture, and Research.
- **Sep 15, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 14, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 14, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
