Employee Business Expense Deduction Reinstatement Act of 2022

This bill allows an individual taxpayer to take into account 85% of any miscellaneous itemized deductions for the taxable year that are unreimbursed expenses paid or incurred by the individual in connection with the performance of services as an employee.
