### Summary (as of Sep 29, 2022)

#### Expanding Home Loans for Guard and Reservists Act

This bill revises a provision that makes full-time National Guard members who serve for a specified period eligible for home loans from the Department of Veterans Affairs to instead make any individual who performed active service for the specified period eligible for the loans.
