Summary (as of Feb 5, 2021)

Reinforcing Impaired Driving Education Act of 2021 or the RIDE Act of 2021

This bill requires the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to establish a two-year pilot program to create and study the effects of a public marketing campaign to raise awareness on driving while under the influence of prescription and over-the-counter medications. The program shall be implemented in states or territories that are most affected by the opioid epidemic.

- **Feb 5, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
