Summary (as of Sep 20, 2022)

Fighting Stimulant and other Substance Use Disorders Act

This bill directs the Inspector General of the Department of Health and Human Services to conduct a review on whether to establish a safe harbor under the anti-kickback statute for evidence-based contingency management incentives and the parameters for such a safe harbor.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 21, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 20, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 20, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
