Summary (as of Mar 23, 2021)

Air Source Heat Pump Act of 2021

This bill allows a new refundable tax credit for qualified air source heat pump expenditures. The bill defines *qualified air source heat pump expenditures* as expenditures for property that uses an air source heat pump to heat and cool a dwelling unit located in the United States and used as the taxpayer's principal residence. The air source heat pump must also meet specified performance and other requirements.
