Summary (as of Sep 20, 2022)

Behavioral Health Integration Awareness Act of 2022

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to (1) conduct outreach to providers on the availability of certain behavioral health integration services under Medicare, and (2) report on the utilization of such services.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 21, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 20, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 20, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
