Restoring Accountability in the Indian Health Service Act of 2022

This bill establishes a series of programs and requirements relating to recruitment and retention in the Indian Health Service, including provisions regarding pay, credentialing, and housing needs of workforce personnel.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 22, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 21, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 21, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Ways and Means, and Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
