VA-SBA Extension Act of 2022

This bill extends until January 1, 2024, the date for transferring from the Department of Veterans Affairs to the Small Business Administration the verification of certain veteran-owned small businesses for the purpose of awarding federal contracts.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 11, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations.
- **Sep 21, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 21, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Small Business, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
