Counter-UAS Authority Extension and Transparency Enhancement Act of 2022

This bill extends and revises provisions related to the protection of certain facilities and assets from unmanned aircraft.

Authority under the bill terminates on October 1, 2023.

- **Sep 22, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
