Summary (as of Sep 22, 2022)

Protecting Reproductive Freedom Act

This bill prohibits states from restricting mifepristone or misoprostol that is approved for medical abortion from being sent across state lines or from being prescribed by telehealth. States are also prohibited from establishing in-person dispensing requirements.
