## Summary (as of Sep 28, 2022)

### Taiwan Policy Act of 2022

This bill provides support to Taiwan and addresses related issues.

For example, the bill (1) establishes a comprehensive training program with Taiwan's government to familiarize the U.S. military and Taiwan's military with each other and achieve interoperability, and (2) authorizes the Department of State to take actions to help Taiwan become a non-borrowing member of the Inter-American Development Bank.

## Actions Timeline

- Sep 29, 2022: Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security, Facilitation, and Operations.
- Sep 28, 2022: Introduced in House
- Sep 28, 2022: Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services, Financial Services, Ways and Means, and Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
