### Summary (as of Sep 28, 2022)

### Hydrogen Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy (DOE) to establish a hydrogen infrastructure finance and innovation pilot program. Under the program, DOE must provide grants and low-interest loans to certain entities for hydrogen infrastructure, including projects for hydrogen transportation, storage, or delivery.

- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Sep 28, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 28, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
