### Summary (as of Sep 29, 2022)

#### Peer-to-Peer Suicide Prevention Act

This bill directs the Department of Education to establish a program to award grants to eligible entities (e.g., local educational agencies) for facilitating peer-to-peer suicide prevention programs for middle and high school students.

### Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
