Summary (as of Sep 29, 2022)

TVA Reform and Consumer Protection Act

This bill makes various changes related to the regulation and operation of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), which provides low-cost electricity in seven southeastern states. For example, the bill (1) eliminates certain restrictions on the sale of power into and out of the Tennessee Valley, and (2) expands the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's oversight of rates and other aspects of the TVA's operations.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
