Summary (as of Sep 29, 2022)

End Lockdowns and Vaccine Mandates Act

This bill prohibits a federal, state, or local government from placing restrictions on opening, remaining in, or entering a place of business (i.e., lockdowns) as part of that government's response to prevent the spread of communicable diseases or from requiring vaccinations in connection with employment.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
