National Museum of American LGBTQ+ History and Culture Act

This bill establishes within the Smithsonian Institution the National Museum of American LGBTQ+ History and Culture.

The museum (1) may carry out educational and liaison programs in support of its goals, and (2) shall establish specified grant and scholarship programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 29, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on House Administration, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
