Commission To Study the Potential Creation of a National Museum of American LGBTQ+ History and Culture Act

This bill establishes the Commission to Study the Potential Creation of a National Museum of American LGBTQ+ History and Culture.

The commission shall submit reports that address

- the feasibility of establishing and maintaining such a museum,
- the availability and cost of collections to be acquired and housed in the museum,
- the impact of the museum on existing American LGBTQ+ history-related museums,
- development of criteria for evaluating possible locations for the museum, and
- the feasibility of the museum becoming part of the Smithsonian Institution.

The commission shall develop a fundraising plan that will address the support of the museum through contributions from the public. No federal funds may be obligated to carry out this bill.
