### Summary (as of Sep 30, 2022)

#### H-2A Reform Act of 2022

This bill requires the Department of Labor to set the adverse effect wage rate applicable to certain temporary foreign workers at an amount equal to 125% of the federal minimum wage minus the value of any other benefit provided to the foreign worker.
