Summary (as of Sep 30, 2022)

States Helping Apprehend Rogue Exports Act

This bill requires states to enter into a data sharing agreement, upon request, with the Department of Homeland Security and the Department of Transportation to provide identifying information regarding any motor vehicle registered in such states in order to be eligible for grants under the Port Infrastructure Development Program, Port Security Grant Program, and the Airport Improvement Program.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 3, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Oct 3, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Transportation and Maritime Security.
- **Sep 30, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 30, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
