Summary (as of Feb 8, 2022)

This resolution sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 3076 (Postal Service Reform Act of 2022) and H.R. 6617 (Further Additional Extending Government Funding Act). The resolution also adopts H.Con.Res. 69 (providing for a joint session of Congress on March 1, 2022, to receive a message from the President) and restricts access to the Hall of the House of Representatives on that date.

- **Feb 8, 2022:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 912.

- **Feb 8, 2022:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 221 - 211 (Roll No. 36).(text: CR H1024)
- **Feb 8, 2022:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 221 - 211 (Roll No. 36). (text: CR H1024)
- **Feb 8, 2022:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Feb 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 7, 2022:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 117-243, by Mr. Raskin.
- **Feb 7, 2022:** The resolution provides for one hour of general debate for both bills. H.R. 6617 is being considered under a closed rule and H.R. 3076 is being considered under a structured rule. The resolution provides that H. Con. Res. 69 is considered adopted and provides that for purposes of the joint session to receive the President of the United States on March 1, 2022, former Members, Delegates, and Resident Commissioners shall not be admitted to the Hall of the House or rooms leading thereto.
