Summary (as of Oct 7, 2022)

Train More Doctors Act of 2022

This bill extends the resident cap building period for purposes of Medicare graduate medical education payments for hospitals that began training residents in a new program between July 1, 2018, and July 1, 2021, to take into account the impact of the COVID-19 public health emergency on these hospitals.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 10, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 7, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 7, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
