Summary (as of Oct 21, 2022)

Public Health Emergency Flexibility Act of 2022

This bill allows specified COVID-19 funding that was made available through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to also be used to address monkeypox. (Monkeypox is a viral disease that is endemic to parts of Africa and causes symptoms similar to, but less severe than, smallpox.)

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 24, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 21, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 21, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Oversight and Reform, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
