## Summary (as of Oct 25, 2022)

### Service Worker Economic Stabilization Act

This bill suspends the disallowance of the tax deduction for business-related entertainment expenses in taxable years beginning in 2023 through 2024 and extends through 2024 the 100% deduction for business meals.
