Dr. Joanne Smith Memorial Rehabilitation Innovation Centers Act of 2022

This bill directs the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to publish and biennially update a list of all rehabilitation innovation centers. The bill defines *rehabilitation innovation centers* as rehabilitation facilities that (1) hold specified federal research and training designations for traumatic brain injury or spinal cord injury research, and (2) serve at least a certain number of Medicare patients. The CMS may waive such criteria as it deems appropriate.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 4, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 3, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 3, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
