## Summary (as of Nov 30, 2022)

### Helping End Lifetime Penalties Act of 2022

This bill limits certain Medicare late enrollment penalties to 12 months (rather than for the lifetime of coverage).

## Actions Timeline

- **Dec 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 30, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 30, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
