Summary (as of Dec 1, 2022)

Pipeline Permitting for Energy Security Act

This bill modifies requirements under the Clean Water Act, the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, and the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to expedite water quality certifications, environmental reviews, endangered species consultations, and make related changes. The bill also establishes requirements to expedite the approval of the Mountain Valley Pipeline, which is a natural gas pipeline located in Virginia and West Virginia.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 14, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Dec 2, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Dec 2, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Dec 1, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 1, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
