Summary (as of Dec 15, 2022)

Creating Low-cost, Efficient And Net-zero Emissions Resilient Buildings Act or the CLEANER Buildings Act

This bill requires the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to establish a national model building performance standards initiative for specified purposes, including to assist state and local governments in the development and implementation of building performance standards. Not later than 2 years after the enactment of this bill, the EPA must develop national model building performance standards.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 16, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Dec 15, 2022:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 15, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
