This resolution expresses that the House of Representatives

- demands an immediate border wall be constructed on the southern border of the United States;
- supports, unequivocally, America's sovereignty and territorial integrity; and
- commits to continuing to support U.S. Customs and Border Protection and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

The resolution also expresses that the House

- pledges to bolster U.S. energy security and reduce its dependence on Russian energy imports, and
- underscores the importance of maintaining U.S. energy independence for the benefit of the American people.

- **Mar 3, 2022:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Homeland Security, Ways and Means, Energy and Commerce, and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
