Summary (as of Dec 21, 2022)

Expanding Transparency for Hidden Independent Campaign Spending Act or the Ethics Act

This bill requires all political committees to notify the Federal Election Commission of any contribution of \$1,000 or more that is received less than 20 days (but more than 48 hours) before an election in which the committee makes a contribution, expenditure, or electioneering communication on behalf of a candidate or political committee of a political party.
