### Summary (as of Dec 30, 2022)

#### Developing Robust Investments in Vehicle Education for Roadway Safety Act or the DRIVERS Act

This bill addresses statewide efforts to improve traffic safety for teen drivers.

Specifically, the bill authorizes states to use highway safety program funding for affordable and accessible classroom-based driving instruction to prepare teens for state graduated driving license requirements.
