Summary (as of Feb 11, 2021)

Vaccine Fairness Act

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to provide weekly reports to Congress concerning the distribution of COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019) vaccines to the public.

HHS must also make publicly available certain data on the number of vaccine doses administered.
