## **Preserving Safety Net Integrity Act of 2021**

This bill prohibits the Department of Homeland Security from rescinding, revising, or suspending the final rule titled *Inadmissibility on Public Charge Grounds*. (Among other changes, the rule expanded the types of public benefits that, if received by an alien, could make that alien a public charge, which may make that alien inadmissible.)
