#### Prescription Pricing for the People Act of 2023

This bill requires the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) to report about anticompetitive practices and other trends within the pharmaceutical supply chain that may impact the cost of prescription drugs. The FTC also must provide recommendations to increase transparency in the supply chain and prevent anticompetitive practices.

- **Mar 1, 2023:** Committee on the Judiciary. Reported by Senator Durbin with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. Without written report.
- **Mar 1, 2023:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 19.
- **Feb 9, 2023:** Committee on the Judiciary. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Jan 26, 2023:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jan 26, 2023:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
