The resolution provides for one hour of debate on each measure and one motion to recommit on H.R. 6323, H.R. 4691, H.R. 5947, H.R. 6046, and H.R. 4639.
- **Apr 16, 2024:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 71.
- **Apr 16, 2024:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H2406-2413)
- **Apr 16, 2024:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1149.
- **Apr 16, 2024:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 1149, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
