Summary (as of Mar 30, 2023)

Accountability for Endless Wars Act of 2023

This bill provides for the automatic termination of laws that authorize the use of military force or declare war.

Any such existing law terminates six months after this bill's enactment; any such future law terminates 10 years after enactment.
