Summary (as of Apr 23, 2024)

This resolution recognizes domestically produced natural gas as affordable, green, and necessary for energy independence while asserting that the United States should take a broad approach to meet energy needs. It also opposes any efforts to limit, delay, or ban the approval of liquified natural gas export facilities in the United States.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 26, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy, Climate and Grid Security.
- **Apr 23, 2024:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 23, 2024:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
