### Summary (as of Feb 24, 2023)

#### Don Young Restoration Grants for Coastlines and Fisheries Act of 2023

This bill requires the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to establish a grant program for projects that (1) restore marine, estuarine, coastal, or Great Lake habitats; or (2) provide adaptation to climate change. State, local, and tribal governments, nonprofit organizations, businesses, and institutions of higher education may apply for grants.

- **Mar 22, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Wildlife, and Fisheries.
- **Feb 27, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Feb 24, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 24, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
