Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4763) to provide for a system of regulation of digital assets by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission and the Securities and Exchange Commission, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5403) to amend the Federal Reserve Act to prohibit the Federal reserve banks from offering certain products or services directly to an individual, to prohibit the use of central bank digital currency for monetary policy, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 192) to prohibit individuals who are not citizens of the United States from voting in elections in the District of Columbia.

- **May 22, 2024:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1243.
- **May 22, 2024:** WORDS TAKEN DOWN - During the course of debate, exception was taken to certain words used and a demand was made to have the words taken down. After review, the Chair ruled that the words were in violation of the spirit of debate. Without objection the words were stricken from the record.
- **May 22, 2024:** DEBATE - The House continued with further debate on H. Res. 1243.
- **May 22, 2024:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 205 - 203 (Roll no. 221).
- **May 22, 2024:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 204 - 203 (Roll no. 222). (text: CR H3414-3415)

- **May 21, 2024:** The resolution provides for one hour of debate on each bill. H.R. 4763 and H.R. 5403 are considered under a structured rule and H.R. 192 is considered under a closed rule. The resolution provides for one motion to recommit on each bill.
