## **Lone Star Reimbursement Act**

This bill requires the Department of Defense and the Department of Homeland Security to each provide \$2.2 billion to the state of Texas as reimbursement for the costs of Operation Lone Star incurred in FY2022 and FY2023.

(Operation Lone Star is a border security operation initiated and carried out by the state of Texas.)

## **Actions Timeline**

---

- **Mar 2, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Oversight, Investigations, and Accountability.
- **Mar 1, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 1, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on Homeland Security, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
