- **Jul 10, 2024:** NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO OFFER RESOLUTION - Mrs. Luna notified the House of her intent to offer a privileged resolution pursuant to clause 2(a)(1) of rule IX.

- **Jul 10, 2024:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1344.
- **Jul 10, 2024:** WORDS TAKEN DOWN - During the course of debate, exception was taken to certain words used and a demand was made to have the words taken down. Mr. McGovern asked unanimous consent to withdraw the words. Without objection, the words were withdrawn.
- **Jul 10, 2024:** DEBATE - The House resumed debate on H. Res. 1344.
- **Jul 10, 2024:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 1344, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
