Saving America's Energy Future Act

This bill prohibits the Department of Agriculture and the Department of the Interior from declaring a moratorium on issuing new oil and gas leases and drill permits on certain federal lands. In addition, the bill prohibits the departments from declaring a moratorium on renewals of such permits.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 4, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Forestry.
- **Mar 22, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Mineral Resources.
- **Mar 3, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 3, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

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
