## Stopping Home Office Work's Unproductive Problems Act of 2023 or the SHOW UP Act of 2023

This bill requires each executive agency to reinstate the telework policies that were in place on December 31, 2019. Agencies may not implement expanded telework policies unless the Office of Personnel Management certifies that such policies, among other requirements, will have a positive effect on the agency's mission and operational costs.

- **Feb 1, 2023:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 75. (consideration: CR H599-607)
- **Feb 1, 2023:** Rule provides for consideration of H.J. Res. 7, H.R. 139, H.R. 382 and H.R. 497. All bills are considered under a closed rule with one hour of general debate and one motion to recommit.
- **Feb 1, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 139.
- **Feb 1, 2023:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- **Feb 1, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.R. 139, the Chair put the question on passage and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Comer demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
