## Summary (as of Mar 9, 2023)

### Affordable Insulin Now Act

This bill limits cost-sharing for insulin under private health insurance.

Specifically, the bill caps cost-sharing under private health insurance for a month's supply of selected insulin products at \$35 or 25% of a plan's negotiated price (after any price concessions), whichever is less, beginning in 2024.

## Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 17, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 9, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 9, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
