Summary (as of Mar 21, 2023)

Social Security Cost of Living Increase Act of 2023

This bill bases cost-of-living adjustments for Social Security benefits on a price index that tracks the spending patterns of older consumers. The Bureau of Labor Statistics of the Department of Labor must publish that price index on a monthly basis.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2024:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Mar 21, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 21, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
