This concurrent resolution directs the President to remove the U.S. Armed Forces from Syria within 180 days of the adoption of this concurrent resolution.

- **Mar 8, 2023:** ORDER OF PROCEDURE - Mr. Massie asked for unanimous consent that it be in order at any time to consider H.Con.Res. 21 in the House if called up by the chair of the Committee on Foreign Affairs or his designee; that the concurrent resolution be considered as read; that the previous question be considered as ordered on the concurrent resolution to adoption without intervening motion except for one hour of debate equally divided among and controlled by Representative McCaul, Representative Meeks, and Representative Gaetz or their respective designees; and that the provisions of section 7 of the War Powers, Resolution, 50 U.S.C 1546, shall not apply to H.Con.Res. 20. Agreed to without objection.
- **Mar 8, 2023:** Consideration initiated pursuant to a previous order.
- **Mar 8, 2023:** Considered pursuant to a previous order. (consideration: CR H1173-1180; text: CR H1173)
- **Mar 8, 2023:** DEBATE - Pursuant to a previous order of the House, the House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Con. Res. 21.
- **Mar 8, 2023:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to a previous order of the House.
- **Mar 8, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Con. Res. 21, the Chair put the question on agreeing to the resolution and by voice vote announced that the noes had prevailed. Mr. Gaetz demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on agreeing to the resolution until a time to be announced.
