This joint resolution nullifies the final rule issued by the Department of Health and Human Services titled *Supporting the Head Start Workforce and Consistent Quality Programming* and published on August 21, 2024. The rule makes regulatory changes to the Head Start Program Performance Standards, including new requirements for staff wages, benefits, and wellness supports.
