### Summary (as of Mar 23, 2023)

This resolution sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 5 (Parents Bill of Rights Act, which establishes rights of parents and guardians regarding the public elementary or secondary school education of their children and withholds federal education funds from local educational agencies and schools that fail to comply with the requirements of the bill).

- **Mar 23, 2023:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 241.
- **Mar 23, 2023:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 241, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Ms. Scanlon demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until a time to be announced.

- **Mar 23, 2023:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 219 - 204 (Roll no. 146). (consideration: CR H1346)
