Summary (as of Apr 13, 2023)

No Federal Funds for Political Prosecutions Act

This bill specifies that no funds or property received through equitable sharing by a state or local enforcement agency with the authority to prosecute a criminal case may be used to investigate or prosecute a current or former President or Vice President, or a candidate for the office of President.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 21, 2023:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 13, 2023:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 13, 2023:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
